Data protection is an important issue and is relevant across the whole of Europe. We therefore expressly support the protection of natural persons who are affected by the processing of their personal data during their participation in the Capital Markets Day. We undertake to comply with the provisions of data protection law, in particular with the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Why is my personal data processed?

We only collect, store, transmit and use personal data to the extent necessary, based on legal regulations and for specific purposes. In detail, the following processing is carried out to enable your participation at the Capital Markets Day:

Provision of the webcast for participation

The Capital Markets Day is an online event. You will take part in a webcast with video and audio transmission and also have the opportunity to ask our speakers questions via the web application.

The following personal data is processed:

- Contact details: Name, company name and e-mail address

- Usage data: Data in connection with the participation in the webcast, e.g. date, duration and scope of your participation in the webcast
- Interaction data: if you use the interaction options of the webcast, e.g. by asking a question, we process the data that you enter when using the interaction

Processing is carried out on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) GDPR. We only process the data that is absolutely necessary to protect the Capital Markets Day from unauthorised access and to enable you to participate in a pleasant and trouble-free manner. For this reason, participation in the Capital Markets Day is unfortunately not possible if the above-mentioned personal data is not provided. All data will be completely deleted after the end of the Capital Markets Day.

The technical realisation of the webcast is carried out by our service provider Company Webcast B.V., a company of the Euronext Group. What rights do I have?

In addition to the right to object mentioned above, you have the following rights:

- Information about your personal data stored in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR in conjunction with § 34 of the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG);
- Correction of your data in accordance with Art. 16 GDPR;
- Deletion of your data in accordance with Art. 17 GDPR;
- Restriction of processing in accordance with Art. 18 GDPR;
- Transferability of your data in accordance with Art. 20 GDPR.
- If you are of the opinion that the processing is in breach of the European Data Protection Basic Regulation, you have the right to appeal to a supervisory authority pursuant to Art. 77 GDPR.

In addition to these site-specific data protection notices, the data protection notices pursuant to the European General Data Protection Regulations also apply.
