Marcus Schulte to become Senior General Manager of pbb

We are gaining a colleague with high-level expertise and many years of experience in the areas of fixed income, debt capital markets, and assets/liability management. Furthermore, he also has a very strong international network with banks and investors."

Until the planned appointment of Marcus Schulte to the Management Board of pbb, Thomas Köntgen, Deputy Chief Executive Officer, will continue to hold responsibility for Treasury at Management Board level as well as being responsible for the business area of Commercial Real Estate Finance.
